14 March 2016 Monday

After breakfast we will travel to the town of Paarl. Here we will visit the KWV Emporium. Spread over 22 hectares, the KWV cellar complex is one of the largest in the world and offers a broad portfolio of products, including sparkling wines, natural wines, fortified wines, liqueurs and brandies.



From here we will travel to the town of Caledon. Here we will visit the wheat, canola and sheep farm of Thys Roux, called "Rouxwil". There are approximately 3 000 sheep on the farm and they farm with a merino crossing, which are called Merino-Dohne. We will enjoy lunch at the farm.



We will also visit the farm of Kevin Williams, called "Jarrahnup". He farms with 1 000 breeding sows and 150 Angus stud cattle (1 000 hectares). Return to Cape Town.

Tonight we will enjoy a special dinner at Gold Restaurant. Before dinner we will enjoy an interactive djembe drumming session. We will enjoy a taste safari with a set 14 course menu, experiencing African cuisine. During dinner Mali Puppets will dance around the tables with drummers and singers.

DAY 3 CAPE PENINSULA – CAPE TOWN – JOHANNESBURG – PRETORIA

Today we will experience the splendour of the Cape Peninsula. We will travel along the Atlantic coast to the Cape of Good Hope Nature Reserve. Nearly 8 000 hectares of indigenous fynbos (fine bush) cover the reserve and about 1 200 plant species have been recorded in the area.



We will also visit Boulders Penguin Colony in Simons Town. It is home to a unique and endangered land-based colony of African Penguins. This colony is one of only a few in the world.



We will also visit Kirstenbosch Botanical Gardens. Kirstenbosch is the headquarters of South Africa's National Botanic Gardens and is the premier centre for the study and propagation of South Africa's indigenous flora. It covers 560 hectares filled with over 6 000 species of trees and plants.

We will take an evening flight to Johannesburg. From here we will be transferred to our hotel in Pretoria.



He farms with Bonsmara cattle (500 cows). He also has a feedlot (8 000 cattle), a bull testing station (600 bulls per year) and a feeding mill on the farm (he uses 2 000 ton of feed per month and sells 4 000 ton).

We will enjoy lunch at the farm.

This afternoon we will visit the abattoir in Kroonstad.

We will also visit a black emerging farmer.

Tonight we will enjoy dinner at the guesthouse.

17 March 2016

Thursday



After breakfast we will travel to the town of Viljoenskroon. Here we will visit the Bonsmara farm of Paul Maree. The Bonsmara is a proudly South African beef breed developed through a scientific crossbreeding programme. The Bonsmara is an early maturing, medium-framed, smooth-coated, heat- and tick-resistant breed with a good temperament. He also farms with corn.

We will also visit Senwes-Bunge. Senwes is one of the leading agribusiness companies in South Africa, established in 1909, with its roots and head office based in Klerksdorp. The company's main business is the provision of input products for agricultural production, market access for grain produce, as well as financial, technical and logistical services to grain producers. Senwes and Bunge have formed a joint venture to develop grains and oilseeds operations in South Africa that will supply the domestic market and export products to other countries in Africa. Management will address us.



From here we will travel to Potchefstroom. We will visit the Celliers family farm of Abraham Celliers and his son-in-law Meyring Hayward. They farm with corn and have a feedlot (500 cattle). We will enjoy lunch at the farm. Return to Pretoria.


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DAY 6
