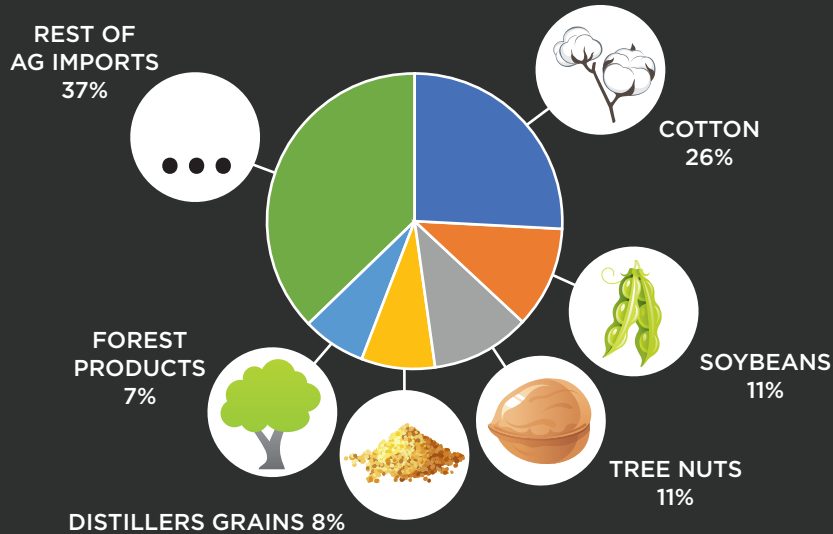

TOTAL U.S. EXPORTS TO VIETNAM

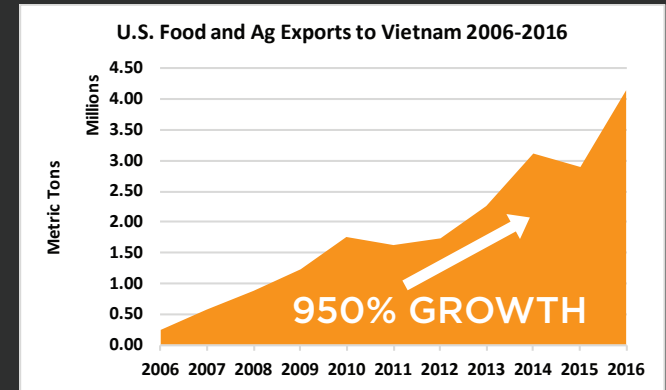


TOTAL IMPORTS FROM VIETNAM
