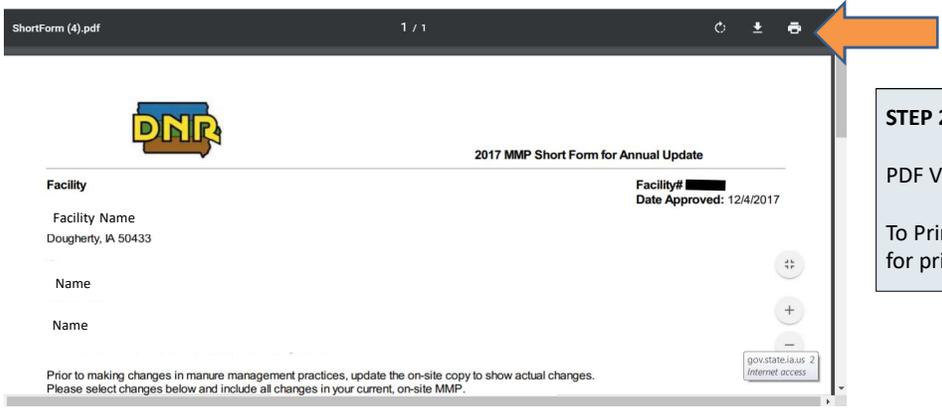

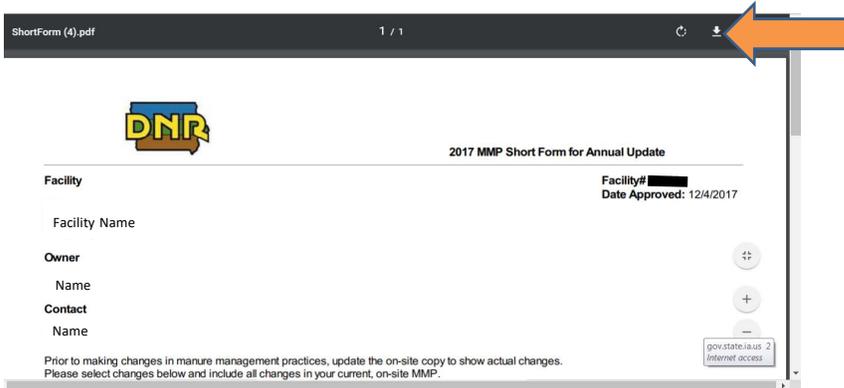


STEP 2

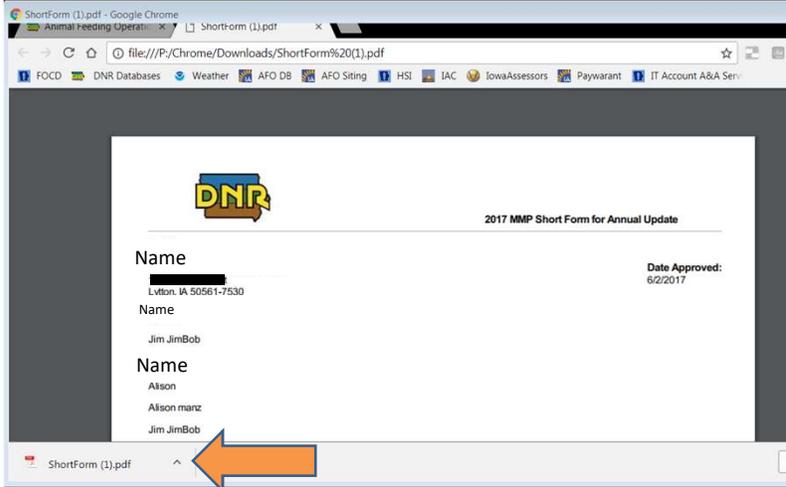


STEP 3

County User Guide - FAQs

1. Is the county required to print/save the electronic copies?

No, DNR rules do not require counties to retain a copy. However, check with your county's records retention policy.

Anyone can go to DNR's eMMP application for an electronic copy

2. Can the county change the email address where notifications are sent?

Yes, please use a general email mailbox that does not change with staffing

If an email address needs to be changed, send the request to DNR's emmpadmin@gmail.com

3. Does this mean that the only way to submit an MMP is through an eMMP?

No, Annual Updates can still be submitted on paper forms

4. Will county staff need a login/password to access the new eMMP online application?

No, county staff can view the submitted Annual Update and other facility information without logging in
