Simplify filing annual manure management plans for

- 7,000-plus livestock and poultry producers
- Their consultants
- 99 counties
- The public
- DNR's six field offices

It's Taken More than a Year

Involved 105 people

- Farmers
- Integrators, Consultants
- Commodity groups
- Iowa counties
- Iowa DNR

10 meetings

480 hours of pre-planning



Streamlined

- Went from 36 to 12 action steps
- Eliminated driving to the county
- Offered online payment
- Reduced incomplete forms
- Offers reminders, emailed notices





Who Needs One?

- Confinements or totally roofed facilities
- More than 500 animal units
 - 1,250 finishing hogs
 - 500 beef or immature dairy cattle
 - 357 mature dairy cattle
 - 50,000 layers, weighing 3 pounds or more

Benefits of an eMMP for Farmers

Ends hand delivery to county offices, saving time and effort

1. Secure, streamlined, automated
2. File from anywhere—home, office or smart phone
3. Pay fees online
4. DNR sends approval & notifies county by email
5. Due date reminders
6. Cuts down on paper storage

Benefits of an eMMP for Counties
