Individuals must be nominated by their county Farm Bureau. The nomination form can be obtained from your county Farm Bureau or downloaded at www.iowafarmbureau.com in the Young Farmer section.

Nominees are judged based on leadership experience, involvement within Farm Bureau and other agriculture organizations.

Nominations are due April 15, 2021.
