# **PRELIMINARY ROUNDS: January 28**

The 2023 Discussion Meet will begin with preliminary rounds at the 2023 Young Farmers Conference on January 27-28 in Des Moines. After two rounds, the top eight finalists will be determined. Final rounds are held during the lowa Farm Bureau Annual Meeting in December 2023.

# **ELIGIBILITY**

Must be 35 years of age or younger as of Jan. 31, 2024, and a regular member in good standing with your county Farm Bureau. Previous state winners and current young farmer advisory committee members are ineligible. Participants may not have received a public speaking fee or honorarium.

### **DISCUSSION MEET TOPICS**

- 1. lowa farmers lead the nation in the use of numerous soil and water conservation practices and have made tremendous progress on reducing nutrient losses through voluntary, market-driven approaches. Despite this progress, critics of the lowa Nutrient Strategy want to see mandates and regulatory requirements. What role can Farm Bureau and/or farmers play in building trust in voluntary, market-driven approaches?
- 2. Animal agriculture is an important part of lowa's economy and a vital protein source. The pandemic amplified the complexity and challenges of our current food supply chain and raised new questions and concerns with consumers. What role can farmers play to help restore consumers' confidence in the food supply system, provide more choices to consumers and protect farmers' livelihoods?
- 3. There is a disconnect between local governments and the farmers who live and work in them. How can Farm Bureau and local farmers foster understanding among local elected officials, planning commissioners and others about impact of land use, taxes, and other local regulations on agriculture and the potential consequences to the community?
