ELIGIBILITY:

Must be 35 years of age or younger as of Jan. 31, 2027, and a regular member in good standing with your county Farm Bureau. Previous state winners, current Young Farmer Advisory Committee members, and current employees or agents of Farm Bureau are ineligible. Participants may not have received a public speaking fee or honorarium.

REGISTRATION:

The preliminary Discussion Meet rounds will take place at the 2026 Young Farmer Conference January 24, 2026 in Des Moines.

Conference registration is open December 1, 2025 -January 9, 2026 through your local county Farm Bureau.

Discussion Meet registration will open Thursday, January 22, 2026 at 7:00 pm in the Whova conference app. Limited to 36 participants on a first-come, first-served basis.
