#### **Looking for Leaders**

The Ag Leaders Institute is for Farm Bureau members who have the potential for providing exceptional leadership in their county, community and state.

It's for people who care about the future of agriculture, and want to make a positive impact.

The institute is open to men and women of all ages. Farm Bureau members who have been nominated by their county are encouraged to apply.

Twenty-five to thirty individuals will participate, with one leader selected from each region and thirteen selected at-large.

Applications are due December 9, 2022. A selection committee will then review applications. Participants who are selected will be notified by Dec. 31.

#### Costs
